

Hello Highland Families!

We hope you're all staying healthy and well!

With social distancing still in place, we have organized our first **crowd-funding fundraiser** for the Highland PTA. Since it's in February, we're calling it "Share the Love." \forall

The idea is that highland families try to generate donations to this fundraiser by:

- 1. <u>Donating yourself</u> if you are in a position to do so
- 2. Asking others for donations
 - a. Here are some ways to ask others for donations
 - i. Have your child/ren call, email or send a letter to friends or relatives, asking them to support their school (see below for example language)
 - ii. Post on your personal social media platforms
 - iii. Tell your community (Highland is a community school!)
 - 1. Neighbors
 - 2. Local businesses

Our goal is a lofty \$20,000, which will benefit Highland School through the Highland PTA. We have in mind renovations to the playground, specifically, starting with the basketball area.

Highland has about 400 kids who attend. Here's an idea of what that means in terms of our \$20,000 goal:

- If every student generates \$50 we will meet the goal
- If half of the student generate \$100 we will meet the goal
- If 25% (a mere 100 kids) of the students who attend Highland generate \$200 each, we will meet our goal.




If, through friends, family and social media, we are able to generate *more* than these baselines, there is a real possibility that we could EXCEED our goal by a TON!



About the platform GIVEBUTTER:


• Donors can give any amount they like! No minimum donation!



• Donors can pay by any method (except cash)



- The above is an example of a \$10 donation. As you can see, the donor is able to cover the credit card fees and "tip" the platform, so that all of the intended donation goes to the PTA. Woohoo!
- The donor can also give a shout out to Highland or to whomever they made the donation on behalf of, by leaving a little note. It looks like this:



• Finally they submit their donation of any amount and it is posted to the cheer board! Here's an example of a couple of real donations! (you can also see these right on the <u>donation page</u>)

• Once the donation has been made, the donor receives a receipt via email, which they can use for tax purposes if they choose to do so. The receipt contains the complete details of the transaction. Here's a snippet of what the receipt looks like (this isn't complete - it's just the top)
